FSC GD respects and protects the privacy of users of the OCP website according to the relevant data protection regulations.

We reserve the right to revise this policy or any part thereof from time to time. We kindly ask you to review this policy periodically for any changes.

The information we collect and how we use this information

1. You can visit our website without submitting any Personal Data - such as your name, address, telephone number, e-mail address, etc. – unless you choose to contact us via e-mail.
2. We automatically collect certain information, which does not qualify as Personal Data, when you visit our site – such as the type of browser and operating system you are using and the domain name of your Internet service provider.
3. Personal Data provided by you will be used solely to respond to your inquiries. We also use non-Personal Data to analyze site usage (such as aggregated information on the pages visited by our users), which allows us to improve the design and content of our site. You can object to the analysis of your site usage by sending an email to privacy@fsc.org.
4. We will not contact you about other matters, unless you specifically request us to do so, nor will we share, rent, or sell your Personal Data to any third party outside the FSC Network. Notwithstanding the foresaid, we may be required to share your information with third parties providing services on our behalf. In addition, we may be required to disclose Personal Data in response to legal proceedings or in situations where we believe, in good faith, that it is required by law, for example, in response to a court order, subpoena or a law enforcement agency's request.

Google Analytics

This website uses Google Analytics, a web analytics service provided by Google, Inc. ("Google"). Google Analytics uses "cookies", which are text files placed on your computer that collect information about your use of this website. This information is being analyzed and used to enhance the functionalities of the website and make it more user friendly. The information collected will be transmitted to and stored by Google on servers in the United States. By activating the IP anonymization on this website, Google will anonymize your IP address within the Member States of the European Union or Member States of the Agreement on the European Economic Area before transmitting them to the United States.
